

# Glastonbury Parks and Recreation Awesome Adventures Camp

## Guidelines & Details

### THE STAFF

The child to staff ratio is 15:1. Our staff consists of college age or older individuals who have had some experience working with this age group. The Director and Site Leaders are certified in first aid and CPR.

### OFF-SITE TRIPS

Transportation by school bus is provided for all off-site activities and trips. Trips and off-site activity admissions are included in the fee for the camp. **Spending money is not included.**

While many smaller field trip locations offer an opportunity for campers to participate in activities as a group, several locations also afford an opportunity for more independence. **Please be aware that on certain field trips (Lake Compounce, Six Flags, Brownstone, Ocean Beach, Powder Ridge and others)** campers will be on his/her own with a buddy. Check-ins will occur periodically to an assigned staff member at a designated location/time. Additionally, Camp Staff will be around the facility and one will be posted at a designated location at all times in the event campers need them. Please make sure you and your child are comfortable and prepared for this type of independence.

**Please note that we do not permit drop off or pick up at field trip locations. Campers must travel to and from ALL field trips with camp staff on transportation provided by the camp.**

### LUNCH

Please send your child with a lunch and beverage that does not need to be refrigerated for on-site days and days where field trips do not provide lunch. On certain field trip days, campers may have the opportunity to purchase lunch at the field trip. Please send money with your child if they will be purchasing lunch on a field trip. **Campers will not be permitted to leave the camp to purchase lunch or have food delivered to camp.**

### BEHAVIOR

Safety, respect for others, and a positive experience are our most important priorities. At camp, staff will discuss their expectations for appropriate behavior and the consequences if they are not followed. We will attempt to curb any inappropriate behavior, however, situations may still occur. If a problem continues, the Director/Site Leader will discuss the situation with you and

attempt to come to some solution. While it is not our policy to discourage participation due to behavior problems, we are limited as to what we may be able to do to work with you to improve the situation. **In cases where there is no marked improvement, the child may be asked to stay home a day and/or be removed from the program.**

Talk with your child on the days camp has met to be sure he/she is having a positive experience. Please inform the Director of any issues your child may be experiencing.

### CAMPER SHIRTS & WRISTBANDS

All campers will receive an Awesome Adventures camp shirt on their first day of camp. Campers will also be given wristbands daily to help identify them as participants in our program. While we do not require campers to wear their camp shirts, it is helpful so staff can easily pick them out in a crowd.

### EXCESSIVE HEAT/HUMIDITY

During periods of excessive heat/humidity, send your child with plenty of liquids (Water & Juice), dressed in appropriate light weight, light color, loose fitting clothing. Be sure they wear sunscreen. We will limit strenuous activity, take frequent breaks, and do our best to stay in shaded areas or indoors during the hottest part of the day. **Some Facilities and buses are not air conditioned.** Please pay attention to the schedule of activities. If you have concerns about your child, please consider keeping them home when high heat/humidity advisories are in effect.

### ADDITIONAL FEES

Additional spending money for off-site activities is not required, but is recommended. Those trips that require money for lunch are detailed in your program calendar. Examples of things that may cost additional money are lockers, video games, snacks and/or souvenirs at field trip locations.

### DROP-OFF/PICK-UP

Camp drop-off and pick-up will be at the Riverfront Park Boathouse Pavilion (252 Welles Street). We can only guarantee that supervision, on regular camp days, will be provided as indicated in the program calendar.

A late fee will be charged to Parent/Guardians picking their child up after the set pickup time for camp. A 10-minute grace period will be given and then a fee of \$15 will be charged for every 15

minutes late that a child is picked up. You will be billed in MyRec. Children who have not been picked up on time may be brought to the Youth & Teen Center for pick-up and parents will be responsible for paying the late fee in addition to the daily fee.

**Please note that we do not permit drop off or pick up at field trip locations. Campers must travel to and from ALL field trips with camp staff on transportation provided by the camp.**

## **SIGN IN/OUT PROCEDURE**

The schedule at the camp varies including quite a bit of activity off-site. Thus, it is essential that staff have a complete list of campers at camp each day.

A staff member will greet campers at the Pavilion. Campers must sign in with their designated group and indicate how they are getting home. At the day's end, campers must sign themselves out of camp and verify how they are getting home.

For your child's protection, we ask that you provide us with a written notice for the following reasons:

- If you plan to pick your child up early.
- If you are authorizing someone, other than yourself or anyone listed on the authorized pick up form when you registered, to pick-up or drop-off your child.
- If your child walks or bikes to camp. Walkers/ bikers must remain at camp until closing unless you inform us otherwise.
- If your child is going to the Youth & Teen Center once camp is over and you did not authorize permission when you registered.

## **YOUTH & TEEN CENTER**

No need to pay \$15 late fees! As an option for parents who may not be able to pick their children up at 3:00 p.m., for an additional fee of \$6/day or \$49 for the whole summer, camp participants can attend the Youth & Teen Center after camp. The Center is open during the summer Tuesday-Thursday until 6:00 p.m. **Parents wishing to have their child utilize the Center must provide authorization at the time of registration or provide a note allowing them to go to there once camp is over.** Campers will be bussed from the Riverfront Park Boathouse Pavilion to the Youth & Teen Center.

## **HEALTH & HYGIENE**

Campers should engage in hand hygiene as often as possible. If a camper is not feeling well, they

should report that to camp staff ASAP. Any camper not feeling well will be sent home and will need to be picked up by their parent. Campers should not return to camp until they are symptom free for 24 hours.

## **MEDICATION ADMINISTRATION**

If your child is on medication, or requires medication in the event of an emergency (i.e., food allergy, asthma, etc.), you must request and complete an Authorization of Administration of Medication Form (even if your child will self-administer) and return it to the Parks and Recreation Office **prior to the start of camp**. Please note that this form requires both a Parent AND physician signature. You may use a school form provided it is not expired.

You may also be required to provide a written treatment form from your physician with specific instructions detailing how and when medication is to be given.

## PROGRAM CALENDAR

Drop off is always at 9:00 a.m. no matter what time is listed as the departure time on the calendar. Pick up is at 3:00 p.m. with the exception of days we visit Lake Compounce and Six Flags (which is a 4:00 pick-up). During on-site time before leaving for a field trip, campers will utilize the Riverfront Park grounds for basketball, use of the playground area and field games. We strongly suggest that campers bring sunblock (minimum SPF 15) with them to camp at all times. Campers are outside daily.

Once at field trip locations, campers will be on his/her own with a buddy. Check-ins will occur periodically to an assigned staff member at a designated location. Supervisory staff will be posted at a designated spot in the event campers should need them.

### SONNY'S PLACE - SOMERS, CT

- Campers may bring a lunch. There is also a food shack for those that wish to purchase lunch.
- The registration fee for camp covers the cost of unlimited batting cages, monkey motion, arcade (excludes redemption arcades), go-karts, XD dark ride, rock walls, zip line, playland, carousel bumper boats, classic mini golf and monkey mayhem mini golf. Additional activities including prize games and food cost additional money.
- **There is a separate PAPER waiver for this trip attached. No camper will be allowed to participate in this trip without a completed waiver.** Print/complete the waiver and send it with your child to camp.

### LAKE COMPOUNCE - BRISTOL, CT

- The registration fee covers the cost of one-day park admission, including access to Crocodile Cove Water Park. Food, special activities and lockers cost additional money.
- Lake Compounce allows one bag/person with a maximum size of 15" x 15" x 15" into the park. In addition, campers can bring outside food/beverages provided they are in a soft cooler no bigger than 12"x12"x12".

- This trip includes water theme park activities. Sunscreen, swimsuits, towels and a change of clothes are highly recommended.
- Lake Compounce only accepts electronic payments including all major credit and debit cards and secure mobile payment systems (Apple Pay, Google/Android Pay, Samsung Pay). Cash is not accepted, however, guests can transfer cash onto a prepaid card at several Cash to Card Kiosks located throughout Lake Compounce.
- **We return to camp at approximately 4:00 p.m. Please note this is later than the normal camp pick-up time.**

#### **POWDER RIDGE PARK - MIDDLEFIELD, CT**

- Campers should bring a lunch. There is a small concession stand that sells sandwiches and beverages at the facility for those that choose to buy lunch, however, the selection is limited and once the sandwiches are gone, they do not make more.
- The registration fee for camp covers the "Mountain Adventure Package" which allows participants to utilize Racing Zip Lines, Paintball Shooting Gallery (100 Paint Balls), Slide the Slopes - Water Slides and Dry Tubing, Disk Golf, Lower Lift Ride/Hike, Horseshoes, Cornhole, Basketball, Wiffleball, Beach Volleyball, Kayaks, Kickball, Bocce and Gaga Ball.
- This trip includes water activities. Sunscreen, swimsuits, towels and a change of clothes are highly recommended.
- **There is a separate waiver for this trip. Click the link below to access trip waiver. No camper will be allowed to participate in this trip without a completed waiver.**

#### **OCEAN BEACH PARK- NEW LONDON, CT**

- Campers may bring a lunch and beverage with them to the park. There are concessions available at the park for campers who wish to purchase their lunch at the beach.
- The registration fee for camp includes all day use of the Olympic size swimming pool and miniature golf. Campers should bring additional money if they wish to play in the arcade or use the slide.
- Please make sure your child is prepared to spend time on the beach by packing sunscreen, towels, bathing suit, and a change of clothes if needed.

#### **BROWNSTONE PARK - PORTLAND, CT**

- Campers should bring a lunch. There is a small concession stand that sells sandwiches and beverages at the facility for those that choose to buy lunch, however, the selection is limited and once the sandwiches are gone, they do not make more.
- The registration fee for camp covers the "Adventure Pass" which allows participants to utilize the 8 water, obstacles, 11 ziplines, rock climbing, giant waterslide, and cliff jumping. All participants MUST wear lifejackets (provided by the facility) and are monitored by certified lifeguards and Awesome Adventures staff.
- This trip includes water activities. Sunscreen, swimsuits, towels and a change of clothes are highly recommended.

#### **STORRS ADVENTURE PARK – STORRS, CT**

- The registration fee covers a safety briefing, harnessing and practice and 3 hours of climbing and ziplining.
- Campers should bring a lunch. There is nowhere to purchase lunch on-site.
- **There is a separate waiver for this trip. Click the link below for the appropriate date to access trip waivers. No camper will be allowed to participate in this trip without a completed waiver.**

### **LESSARD LANES – PLAINVILLE, CT**

- Campers may bring a lunch. There is also a snack area for those that wish to buy lunch.
- The registration fee for camp covers the cost of 3 hours of bowling and indoor mini golf. Additional activities including arcades and food cost additional money.

### **SIX FLAGS NEW ENGLAND- AGAWAM, MASSACHUSETTS**

- The registration fee covers the cost of regular admission rides and the water park.
- Six Flags does not allow us to bring food into the amusement park (with the exception of those with documented food allergies). Children must bring money for lunch as well as any additional spending money they may need. Children will also need money for coin operated lockers if they wish to store any belongings during the course of the day.
- Six Flags New England only accepts card and mobile payments at all in-park locations including restaurants, retail stores, games, ticket windows, and all parking toll booths. No cash? No problem! Visit one of the kiosks in the park to take advantage of the cash-to-a-card program, which allows you to convert your cash to a prepaid debit card. Not only can you use this card throughout your visit, feel free to use leftover funds anywhere in the U.S. where VISA is accepted.
- Once at Six Flags, campers will be on his/her own with a buddy. Check-ins will occur periodically to an assigned staff member at a designated location. Supervisory staff will be posted at a designated spot in the event campers should need them. **We will return to the camp site at approximately 4:00 p.m. Please note this is later than the normal camp pick-up time.**

### **GREAT WOLF LODGE – MASHANTUCKET, CT**

- Great Wolf Lodge does not allow us to bring food into facility (with the exception of those with documented food allergies). Children must bring money for lunch as well as any additional spending money they may need for the arcade.
- Great Wolf Lodge is a cashless facility. They only accept card and apple pay payments.
- The registration fee for camp covers all day use of the water park. Lifeguards are stationed throughout the park and life jackets are available if needed.
- This trip includes water activities. Sunscreen, swimsuits, towels and a change of clothes are highly recommended.

### **DAVE & BUSTERS - MANCHESTER, CT**

- Campers **DO NOT NEED TO BRING A LUNCH** because food (flatbread pizza, smashed burger sliders, garlic butter pretzel sticks, crispy chicken bites with ranch, french fries, seasonal fruit and unlimited soft drinks) will be provided.
- The registration fee for camp also includes a \$20 power card (for ticketed games) plus unlimited video game play. Please send your child with additional money if you think they may want to add money to their cards.

### **SPARE TIME - VERNON, CT**

- Campers may bring a lunch. There is also a restaurant and snack area for those that wish to buy lunch.
- The registration fee for camp covers the cost of 2 hours of bowling and 2 games of laser tag. Additional activities including arcades and food cost additional money.



## **Sonny's Place Waiver & Release of Liability & Safety Rules**

In consideration of Sonny's Place furnishing services and/or equipment to enable me to participate in activities and services, included but not limited to all activities and services at Sonny's Place.

I fully understand and acknowledge that; (a) risks and dangers exist in my use of Batting Cages, Carousel, Climbing Walls, Monkey Motion, Mini Golf, Bumper Boats, Laser Tag, Zip Line, Go-Kart, Playland, Arcade, Virtual Reality Games, and/or equipment provided and for my participation in activities; (b) my participation in such activities and/ or use of such equipment may result in my injury or illness including but not limited to bodily injury, disease strains, fractures, partial and/ or total paralysis, eye injury, blindness, heat stroke, heart attack, death or other ailments that could cause serious disability; (c) these risks and dangers may be caused by the negligence of the owners, employees, officers or agents of Sonny's Place, the negligence of the participants, the negligence of others, accidents, breaches of contract, the forces of nature or other causes. These risks and dangers may arise from foreseeable or unforeseeable causes; and (d) by my participation in these activities and / or damages, whether caused in whole or in part by the negligence or other conduct of the owners, agents, officers, employees, of Sonny's Place or by any other person. Guest(s) suspected to be under the influence of a substance or alcohol are not authorized to use park attractions or rides and at the digression of management and can be ejected from the park. Sonny's Place may terminate alcohol service to any guest(s) at any time for any reason.

I, on behalf of myself, my personal representatives and my heirs, hereby voluntarily agree to release, waive, discharge, hold harmless, defend and indemnify Sonny's Place and its owners, agents, officers and employees from any and all claims, actions or losses for bodily injury, property damage, wrongful death, loss of services or otherwise which may arise out of my use of activities, services or consumption of products offered. I specifically understand that I am releasing, discharging and waiving any claims or actions that I may have presently or in the future for the negligent acts or other conduct by the owners, agents, officers or employees of Sonny's Place.

1. Children under 12 must be accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult.
2. No running.
3. Proper attire, including shoes or sandals, must be worn at all times. Attire should be appropriate for a family setting and not contain profanity or inappropriate images.
4. No outside food or beverage, including alcohol, is permitted at the park.
5. No pets, except properly marked and documented service animals are permitted in the park.
6. Food & Drink are not permitted on any attraction.
7. Smoking, including the use of e-cigarettes is not permitted in the park, only in the parking lot.

8. Drugs, including marijuana and medical marijuana, are strictly prohibited on Sonny's Place property.
9. Line jumping is not permitted — it may be grounds for ejection from the park.
10. Guests using profanity, abusive language, or gestures is also very rude and may result in ejection from the park.
11. Knives, firearms, fireworks/explosives, mace/pepper spray, or any other weapons are not permitted in the park.
12. Offensive behavior, fighting, or horse play may be cause for ejection from the park.
13. Drones are not permitted at any time.
14. Guests are required to follow all posted warnings and rules for specific attractions and areas of the park.
15. Sonny's Place reserves the right to eject a guest or group of guests without refund.
16. A waiver must be completed to gain access to park amenities.
